**Nordby Construction Completes Phase I of The Children's Village
*The First Innovative Model Project Built on the West Coast***

SANTA ROSA – October 1, 2006 – Nordby Construction, a leading North Bay construction company, completed construction of the first phase of a multi-phased project for the Children's Village of Sonoma County, a non-profit organization providing a multi-generational foster care housing community in Santa Rosa.

Phase I of the Children's Village consists of a unique community with four single-family, two-story homes, and a triplex, all designed to house children and their siblings in foster care, as well as trained village "parents" and "grandparents". The community is intended to create a stable, family environment on a long-term basis for children and their siblings in the foster care system. The Children's Village is the first model project of this type on the West Coast. Architect Archumana of Santa Rosa designed the village model housing project.

The four single-family homes total 12,600-sq.-ft., each with six bedrooms and garages, and will house both children and village parents. The 2,600-sq.-ft. triplex provides housing for the grandparents, and include carports and storage. Phase II will involve the construction of a community center with meeting rooms, administrative offices, arts and crafts room, library and computer room, and additional housing will be constructed in the future.

“Working with Nordby Construction was a true partnership,” said Lia Rowley, Executive Director of the Children’s Village. “There was a lot of give and take between all of us, and it was a cooperative effort.”

Phase II construction is expected to commence in the Spring of 2007.
